An Act to enable the City Commissioners to levy City Rates for the current half-year. [Assented to, 29th December, 1856.]

B^E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the Preamble. advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :--

1. The Commissioners of the City of Sydney shall for the general Rate of 4d. in the purposes of the said City collect as soon as convenient for the now current pound on present assessment for curhalf-year a rate of four pence in the pound on the whole of the property in rent half-year. the City according to its present assessed value.
