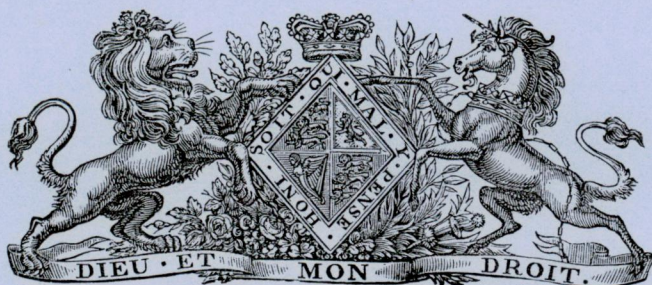

An Act to increase the Salaries of the Judges of the Supreme Court. [Assented to, 6th January, 1857.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to increase the Salaries of the Judges of the Supreme Court of New South Wales: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. From and after the first day of January now next the Salaries of the respective Judges of the Supreme Court shall be of the amounts set forth in the Schedule hereto annexed.

2. Provided nevertheless that the amount of Pensions to be demandable by the said respective Judges on permanent disability or infirmity or after fifteen years service as such Judge in this Colony shall notwithstanding the increase of salary hereby granted continue to be of the amounts at present fixed by law and no more.

Pensions to remain as provided by the Constitution Act.
