An Act to provide for the Disposal of the Parramatta Domain. [Assented to, 18th March, 1857.]

HEREAS it is expedient to make provision for the better disposal Preamble. of the Parramatta Domain: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales, in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. It shall be lawful for the Governor, with the advice of the Parramatta Domain Executive Council, to sell or otherwise dispose of the lands known as the ordinary Waste Parramatta Domain, in all respects as ordinary Waste Lands of the Lands, with exceptrown, provided that a portion thereof not being less than two hundred acres in extent shall be reserved from sale, and shall be set apart for and granted as a Park for promoting the health and recreation of the inhabitants of the Town of Parramatta.
