### No. VI.

An Act to revive and make perpetual the Act "To prevent for  
"a limited time Party Processions and certain other  
"Public Exhibitions in the Colony of New South Wales."  
[Assented to, 6th January, 1857.]

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in this present Parliament Assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That the Act of Council ten Victoria number one passed "*To prevent for a limited time Party Processions and certain other Public Exhibitions in the Colony of New South Wales*" shall be and the same is hereby revived and made perpetual.
