An Act to appropriate and apply certain sums raised or to be raised under the Sydney Sewerage Act of 1853, and the Sydney Water Act of 1853, for the service of the Year 1857. [Assented to, 18th March, 1857.]

DE it enacted, by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, with the Preamble. advice and consent of the Legislative Council, and the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales, in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-

1. Out of any sum or sums of money borrowed, or to be borrowed May be applied for in pursuance of the provisions of the Sydney Sewerage Act of 1853, there Sewerage not exceed-ing £35,575 for 1857. shall and may be issued and applied, any sum or sums of money not exceeding thirty-five thousand five hundred and seventy five pounds, to defray the probable expenditure required for the Sydney Sewerage Works, under the said Act, for the Year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven.

2. Out of any sum or sums of money borrowed, or to be borrowed For Water not ex-in pursuance of the provisions of the Sydney Water Act of 1853, there ceeding £93,413 for 1857. shall and may be issued and applied, any sum or sums of money not exceeding ninety-three thousand four hundred and thirteen pounds to defray the probable expenditure of the Sydney Water Works under the said Act, for the Year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven.

3. The Treasurer of the said Colony shall issue and pay the said Treasurer to pay several sums to such persons for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, warrant, warrant, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor by any Warrant or order in writing under his hand and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct.

4. The said Treasurer shall, in his accounts from time to time, and to receive credit be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him in pursuance for same. of such Warrant or order in Writing as aforesaid, and the receipt or receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer, in passing his said accounts, for any such sum or sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
