An Act to enable the Government to raise Loans for certain Public Works and to pay off certain Land and Immigration Debentures falling due in 1860.

WHEREAS it is expedient to authorize the Government to borrow Preamble. certain sums amounting in the whole to three hundred and forty-eight thousand two hundred and twenty-three pounds for the several Public Works hereinafter specified and to pay off certain Land and Immigration Debentures falling due in 1860 and to amend the Act eighteenth Victoria number thirty-five Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. It shall be lawful for the Governor with the advice of the Executive Council to raise by the sale of Debentures secured upon the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony and bearing interest at a rate not exceeding five per centum per annum such several sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of three hundred and forty-eight thousand two hundred and twenty-three pounds as may be required for the following several purposes not exceeding for the same respectively the following several sums that is to say:—

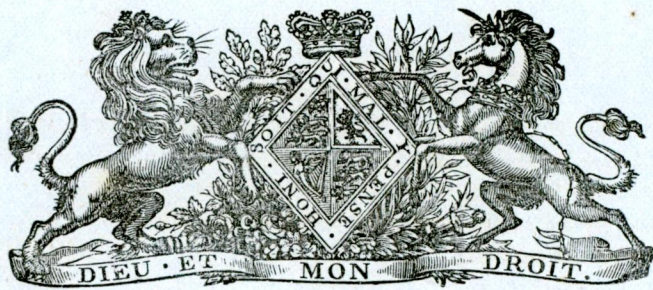
