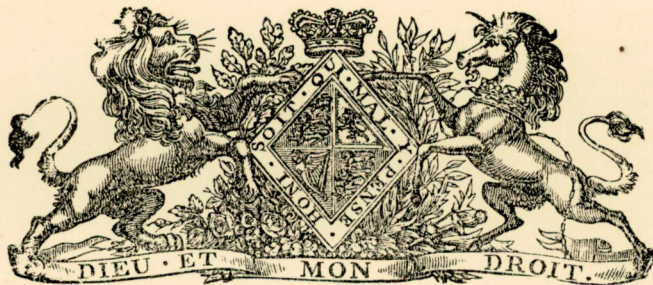

An Act to remove doubts as to the Impounding of Cattle.

**W**HEREAS doubts have been raised as to the right of impounding Preamble.  
cattle by conditional purchasers of Crown Lands under the  
Crown Lands Alienation Act of 1861 Be it declared and enacted by  
the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and  
5 consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New  
South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the  
same as follows:—

1. It shall be lawful for every conditional purchaser of Crown  
land under the Crown Lands Alienation Act of 1861 residing upon  
10 such land within the meaning of the same Act to exercise all the same  
and the like rights of impounding cattle sheep goats or swine tres-  
passing upon such land as may be exercised by any owner and occupier  
of land or occupier of Crown Lands under lease or license within the  
meaning of the Impounding Act or Acts now in force and all the  
15 provisions of such Act or Acts applicable to any case of impounding  
by such owners and occupiers and occupiers of Crown Lands under  
lease or license shall apply to every like case of impounding by any  
such conditional purchaser.

2. This Act may be cited as the "Cattle Impounding  
20 Declaratory Act of 1864."

An Act to amend the provisions of the Land Ordinance of 1891.

WHEREAS the provisions of the Land Ordinance of 1891, in relation to the right of landowners to acquire title to land within the meaning of the said Act, are hereby amended...

1. It shall be lawful for every conditional purchaser of land under the Land Ordinance of 1891, or any person who has acquired title to land within the meaning of the said Act to exercise all the rights and the rights of landowners...

2. This Act may be cited as the "Title Ordinance of 1902."
