An Act to amend the Gold Fields Act of 1861.

WHEREAS by the "Gold Fields Act of 1861" it is enacted that Preamble. for any Gold Field a Court of Appeal shall be established and shall consist of a Chairman and two other persons who have held Miners' Rights for six months to be appointed by the Governor with
