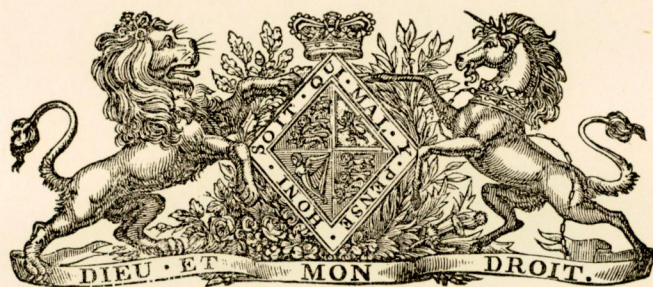

An Act to amend the Law relating to the Salary of every future Governor.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Law relating to the Salary of every future Governor Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. So much and such parts of sections forty-nine and fifty of the Constitution Act ratified by Her Majesty under the Imperial Act eighteen and nineteen Victoria chapter fifty-four and so much of Schedule A to the said Constitution Act as relate to and provide for the Salary of the Governor General shall be and are hereby repealed.

Sections 49 and 50 and Schedule A. to Constitution Act 18 and 19 Vic. cap. 54 in part repealed.

2. There shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund in each and every year to the present Governor the sum of Seven Thousand Pounds and to every future Governor the sum of Five Thousand Pounds.

Amount of salary.

3. This Act shall be styled and may be cited as the "Governor's Salary Act of 1861."
