

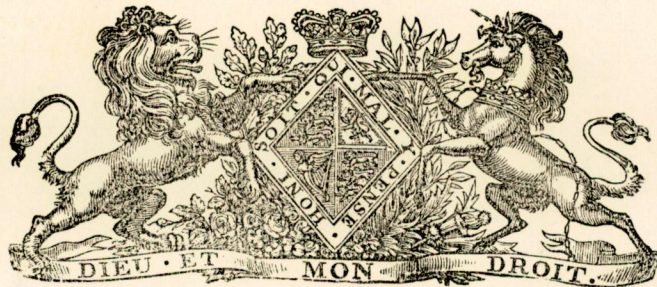

WHEREAS by the Kiama Tonnage Act of 1861 a Tonnage Duty Preamble.

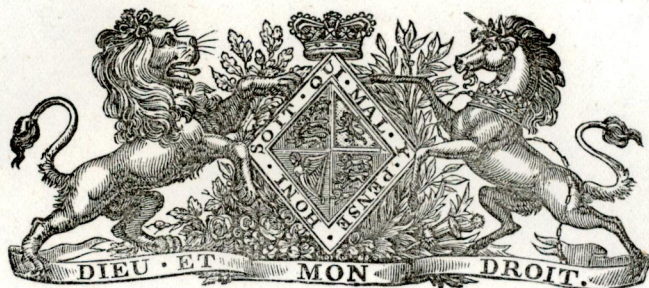
