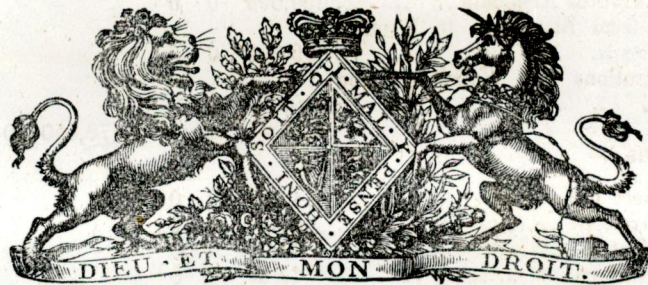

An Act to enable the Government to raise a Loan for certain
Public Works and for other purposes.

WHEREAS it is expedient to authorize the Government to borrow Preamble.
certain sums of money amounting in the whole to One million
seven hundred and eighty-two thousand three hundred and seventy
pounds fourteen shillings and sixpence for the several purposes herein-
after specified Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent
Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled
and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. It shall be lawful for the Governor with the advice of the
Executive Council to raise by the sale of Debentures secured upon the Loan of
Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony and bearing interest at a rate £1,782,370 14s. 6d.

not exceeding in the whole the sum of One million seven hundred and
eighty-two thousand three hundred and seventy pounds fourteen shillings

Public Loan—1862.

2. All sums borrowed under this Act shall be paid to the Colonial Treasurer and shall be by him placed to the credit of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and shall be applied towards the respective purposes for which the same shall have been so raised and shall be accounted for in the same manner as if they had formed part of the Current Annual Revenue of the Colony. Sums borrowed how to be accounted for.

3. The said Treasurer shall issue and pay the said several sums for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned to such persons upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor by any warrant or order in writing under his hand and directed to the said Treasurer shall from time to time order and direct and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the sums so borrowed as aforesaid. Treasurer to pay under Governor's Warrant

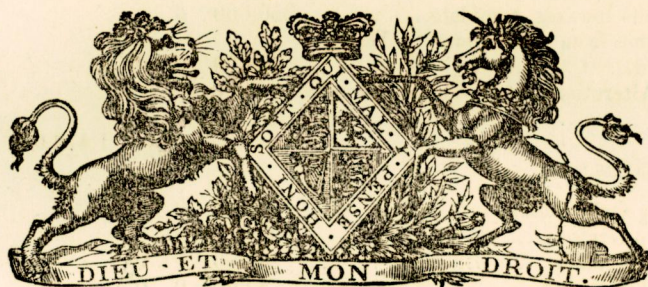
4. The said Treasurer shall in his Accounts from time to time be allowed credit for every sum of money paid by him in pursuance of such warrant or order in writing as aforesaid and the receipt of each and every person to whom the same shall be so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for each sum therein mentioned and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly. and to receive credit for same.

3. The new borrower under this Act shall be paid to the Federal Reserve Bank of New York or any other place to the credit of the Federal Reserve Bank of New York, and shall be credited to the account of the borrower for the purpose of the loan. The amount of the loan shall be accounted for in the same manner as if they had been paid out of the Federal Reserve Bank of New York.

4. The said Treasurer shall issue and pay the said several checks to the persons mentioned in such person upon and to whom they are payable to the order of the borrower by any bank or other institution under his hand and signature to the said Treasury Department from time to time and these and the payments so made shall be charged to and payable out of the moneys so borrowed as provided.

5. The said Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be credited with every sum of money paid by him in pursuance of this Act or under his authority as aforesaid and the receipt of each and every person to whom the same shall be so paid shall be a full and valid receipt to the said Treasurer in respect of such sums and he shall receive credit for the same amount.
