An Act to authorize a Treaty respecting Customs Duties on Goods crossing the Queensland Boundary.

WHEREAS it is expedient that some arrangement should be made Preamble. respecting the collection of Customs Duties on Goods crossing the Boundary between this Colony and Queensland Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and 5 consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New


