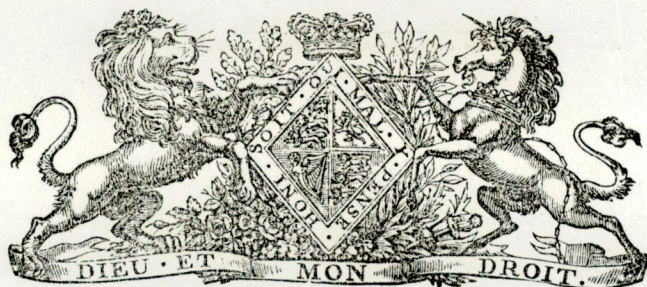

2. This Act shall be held to extend and apply to any Public Bridge Public Bridges over boundary rivers. crossing a river which forms part of the boundary line between this and any other Colony Provided that as to any such Bridge being the joint property of the two Colonies any arrangement may be made between the  
5 Governments of such two Colonies respecting the collection division and appropriation of the Bridge Tolls and dues thereon.

3. This Act shall be styled and may be cited as the "Public Short Title. Bridges Tolls Act of 1861."

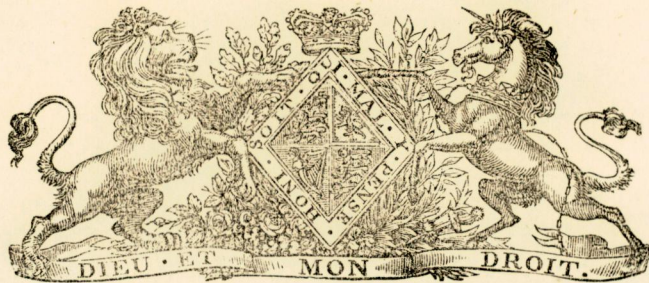
