2. All sums borrowed under this Act shall be paid to the sums borrowed how Colonial Treasurer and shall be by him placed to the credit of the <sup>to be</sup> accounted for. Consolidated Revenue Fund and shall be applied towards the respective purposes for which the same shall have been so raised and shall be accounted for in the same manner as if they had formed part of the Current Annual Revenue of the Colony.
