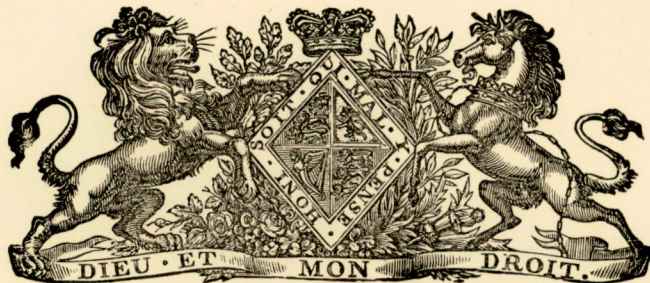

An Act to amend the Scab Act of 1861.

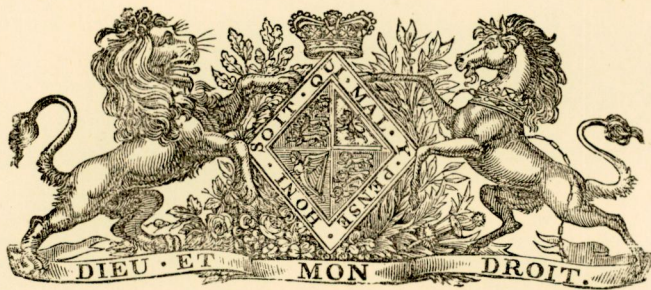
WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal so much of the "Scab in Preamble.
Sheep Act of 1861" as provides for the destruction of infected
sheep Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent
Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative

of the said Act shall be entitled to the same compensation as would
have accrued had the said sections not been repealed.

An Act to amend the Scab Act of 1861. [Assented to, 22nd September, 1863.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal so much of the "Scab in Preamble. Sheep Act of 1861" as provides for the destruction of infected sheep Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The second third sixth and seventh sections of the said recited Act are hereby repealed except so much of the said sections as may be necessary for carrying out the provisions of the seventeenth section of the said Act Clauses 2 3 6 and 7 repealed. Provided that any person whose sheep shall Proviso. have been or may be hereafter injured or destroyed by the operation of the said Act shall be entitled to the same compensation as would have accrued had the said sections not been repealed.

An Act to amend the Statute in Force in Victoria, (Enacted in the 18th Year of Her Majesty's said Majesty Queen Victoria, in the first Session of the third Parliament.)

W HEREBY it is enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty in Council, that the Statute in the first Section of the said Act, and the Statute in the second Section of the said Act, shall be amended in the manner therein expressed, and that the Statute in the third Section of the said Act shall be repealed.
