WHEREAS it is expedient to alter the duties imposed by the Preamble. "Customs Duties Act of 1855" on imported Tobacco Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly 5 of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :---
