1. It is hereby enacted that the law in relation to the powers and duties of the members of the Council in relation to the Council of Ministers shall be as follows:—

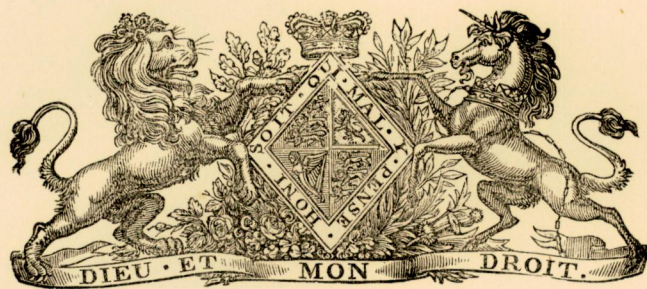
