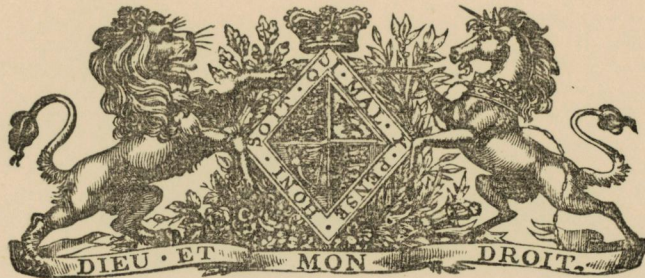

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to amend in certain particulars an Act Preamble.  
passed in the tenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen  
Victoria intituled "*An Act to amend the Law respecting the recovery* 10 Vic. No. 10.  
*of Small Debts in all parts of the Colony*" and to extend the juris-  
5 diction of the Courts of Petty Sessions Be it therefore enacted by the  
Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent  
of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South  
Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as  
follows:—

10 1. So much of the proviso of section eight in the said recited Repeal of part of  
Act as enacts that the granting of new trials in certain cases shall be 10 Vic. No. 10.  
conditional upon the defendant paying the costs of the first trial and  
giving such security for the costs of the new trial as the Court of  
Petty Sessions shall think fit to require is hereby repealed and in sub-  
15 stitution thereof it is hereby enacted that the said Court may upon  
sufficient cause being shewn and independently of the payment by him  
of any such costs or of the giving of any such security grant a new  
trial in any cause upon such terms as such Court may think fit.

20 2. All the provisions of the Acts fourteen Victoria number Provisions of 14 Vic.

writs of prohibition are hereby extended to and shall apply to cases 39 partly extended

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to amend in certain particulars an Act <sup>Preamble.</sup> passed in the tenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria intituled "*An Act to amend the Law respecting the recovery* <sup>10 Vic. No. 10.</sup> *of Small Debts in all parts of the Colony*" and to extend the jurisdiction <sup>5</sup> operation of the Courts of Petty Sessions Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

10 1. So much of the proviso of section eight in the said recited Act as enacts that the granting of new trials in certain cases shall be conditional upon the defendant paying the costs of the first trial and giving such security for the costs of the new trial as the Court of Petty Sessions shall think fit to require is hereby repealed and in sub-  
 15 stitution thereof it is hereby enacted that the said Court may upon sufficient cause being shown and ~~independently of the payment by him of any such costs or of the giving of any such security for that purpose~~ set aside any judgment given in the absence of the defendant and grant a new trial ~~in any cause~~ upon such terms as such Court may think fit.

20 2. All the provisions of the Acts fourteen Victoria number <sup>Provisions of 14 Vic. No. 43 17 Vic. No. 39 partly extended to 10 Vic. No. 10 and this Act.</sup> forty-three and seventeen Victoria number thirty-nine relative to writs of prohibition are hereby extended to and shall apply to cases arising under the tenth Victoria number ten and under this Act.

25 3. 2. The said recited Act amended as hereinbefore provided shall be in force and apply to all parts of the Colony **except the Police District of Sydney.** <sup>Operation of 10 Vic. No. 10 extended to all parts of the Colony.</sup>

4. ~~Section thirty seven of the said recited Act is also hereby repealed.~~

5. This Act may be cited as the "~~Small Debts Recovery Act~~ <sup>Short title.</sup> Amendment Act."
