HEREAS it is desirable to amend the Boundaries of the City of Preamble. VV Sydney as fixed by the Act of Council twentieth Victoria number thirty-six and to include within such boundaries the lands severally known as the Sydney Common and No Man's Land Be it 5 therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :-
