To amend the Treason Felony Act of 1868.

WHEREAS an Act was passed by the Parliament of New South Preamble.

Wales in the thirty-first year of the reign of Her present

Majesty Queen Victoria intituled "An Act for the better security of

"the Crown and Government of the United Kingdom and for the better

5 "suppression and punishment of seditious practices and attempts"

And whereas it is expedient to repeal certain of the clauses contained in the said Act Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent

Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled

10 and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The ninth and tenth sections of the Act of Council thirty Repeal of part of 30 Vic. No. 25. Victoria number twenty-five shall be and are hereby repealed.
