An Act to reduce the Salaries of future Governors.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

- 5 1. So much of Schedule A to the Act of the Imperial Parliament eighteenth and nineteenth Victoria chapter fifty-four as places at the disposal of Her Majesty for the salary to be paid to future Governors the sum of Seven thousand pounds is hereby repealed. Repeal of part of Schedule A to 18 and 19 Vic. cap. 54.
- 10 2. There shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund in each year to the Governor of the Colony for the time-being the sum of Five thousand pounds. Salary of future Governors to be £5,000.
- 15 3. Nothing in this Act (which may be cited as the "Future Governors' Salaries Reduction Act") shall affect the Salary of the present Governor but the same shall be paid to him during his administration in accordance with the scale set forth in the said Schedule hereinbefore in part repealed. Saving of salary of present Governor.
