An Act to amend the Act 24 Vict. No. 21 intituled "An Act to limit the Liability of Mining Partnerships."

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and concert of the Leviel the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :---

1. The Act twenty-fourth Victoria number twenty-one shall in Extension of Mining Partnerships Act. 5 addition to the Companies described in section one thereof apply and extend to Companies formed or to be formed for the purpose of working coal cannel coal bituminous shales or shales from which petroleum or naphtha can be extracted or of quarrying granite marble or 10 limestones for building or other purposes or of obtaining any precious

stones or gems by any mode or method mentioned in the said section.

2. This Act shall be construed with and form part of the Act short title and twenty-fourth Victoria number twenty-one and may be cited as the ^{construction}. "Liability of Mining Partnerships Limitation Act Amendment Act 15 of 1870.'
