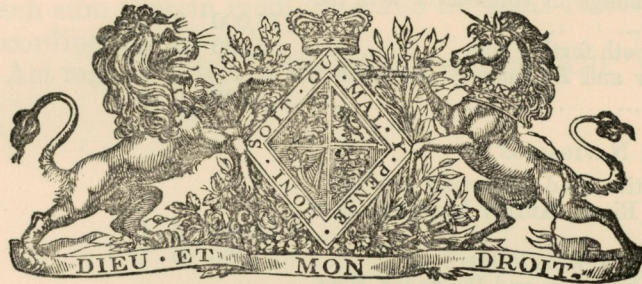

WHEREAS it is expedient to authorize the Government to borrow Preamble.
certain sums of money amounting in the whole to Seven hundred and twenty-nine thousand eight hundred and sixty-one pounds six shillings and one penny for the several purposes hereinafter specified
5 Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—
