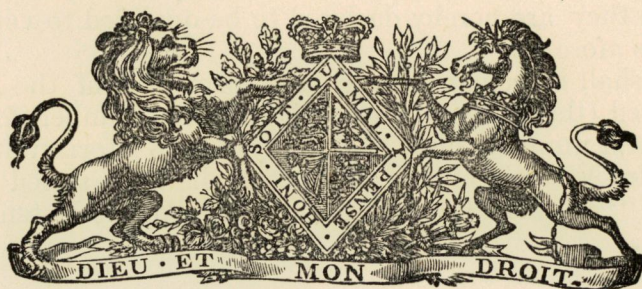

An Act to authorize the Municipal Council of Sydney to make Assessments and collect Rates and to provide for the conduct of Elections in accordance with the Amended Boundaries of the said City and the several Wards thereof.

**W**HEREAS by the Act of Council thirty-third Victoria number nine Preamble.  
the boundaries of the City of Sydney and of the several Wards thereof were declared to be those described in Schedules A and B of the said Act respectively And whereas it is expedient that the making of  
5 assessments and collection of rates by the Municipal Council of the said City and the holding of Elections in the said Wards should be regulated in certain respects in accordance with the provisions of the said Act Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
10 and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :—

1. It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of the City of Sydney to cause assessments to be made and to enforce the collection of rates in respect of all rateable property included within each and  
15 every ward of the said City as described in Schedule B of the Act of Council thirty-third Victoria number nine. Municipal Council of Sydney empowered to levy rates according to amended ward boundaries.

2. For the purposes of carrying out the provisions of section one of this Act it shall be lawful for the said Council to assess and collect the rates in the said section mentioned in accordance with and on the posting of the entries and description in the existing assessment and rate books of the said Council until a new assessment for the entire City as described in Schedule A of the said recited Act shall have been made and after the making of such new assessment then in accordance with and on the posting of such new assessment Provided however that it shall be lawful for the said Council to cause supplementary assessment and rate books to be made out in respect of any rateable property situated within any of the Wards described in the said Schedule B although such property shall not be included in the said existing assessment and rate books.

Existing assessment and rate books to be used until new assessment of the City.

3. For the purposes of the next ensuing and all future elections of Aldermen and other officers of the said Council now by law elected in and for the several Wards of the said City all ratepayers entitled in respect of property situated within any Ward of the City of Sydney as described in the said recited Act shall if otherwise by law entitled in that behalf be and they are hereby declared to be qualified to vote at any such election as aforesaid.

Elections in wards according to amended boundaries.

4. This Act shall be construed with and form part of the Acts hereinafter mentioned (that is say) fourteenth Victoria number forty-one twentieth Victoria number thirty-six twenty-third Victoria number seven and thirty-third Victoria number nine and shall be styled and may be cited as the "Municipal Council of Sydney Powers Extension Act of 1870."
