

# A BILL

To amend the "Randwick and Coogee Roads Transfer Act of 1869"  
by authorizing the removal of the Randwick Toll-gate.

[MR. ALEXANDER CAMPBELL;—12 November, 1874.]

**W**HEREAS under and by virtue of the provisions of an Act of Preamble.  
the Governor and Parliament of New South Wales passed in  
the thirty-second year of the Reign of Her present Majesty Queen  
Victoria and numbered nine a certain road extending about one  
5 hundred and thirty-seven chains from Botany-street in the City of  
Sydney through the Sydney Common and Water Reserve to the gate  
at the entrance to the Randwick Racecourse has been duly transferred  
to the Municipal Council of Sydney and that portion of the said road  
extending about one hundred and seventy-seven chains from the said  
10 racecourse gate to the waters of Coogee Bay has been duly transferred  
to the Municipal Council of Randwick as by law provided And  
whereas it is desirable to remove the Toll-gate now in existence upon  
the said road and erect the same upon another part of the said road  
Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and  
15 with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative  
Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the  
authority of the same.

1. It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of Sydney and Municipal Councils  
of Sydney and Rand-  
wick may remove  
Toll-gate.  
the Municipal Council of Randwick to remove the Toll-gate now  
20 standing and being on the Randwick Road and to erect the same and  
collect tolls thereof at a point about one hundred yards therefrom in  
a north-westerly direction on the said Randwick Road anything in any  
Act hereinbefore contained to the contrary notwithstanding.

2. This Act shall be styled and cited as the "Randwick Toll- Short title.  
25 gate Removal Act."
