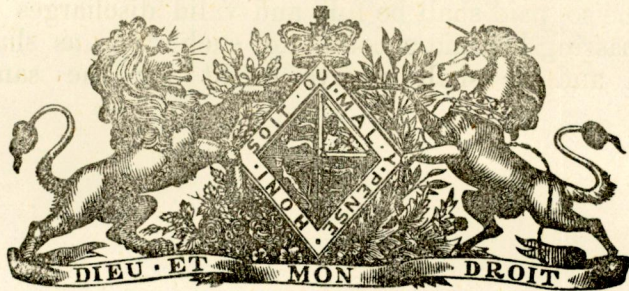

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales towards the Services of the Year 1876.

**W**HEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects Preamble.  
the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales  
in Parliament assembled have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the  
sum of One hundred and eighty-six thousand eight hundred and sixty-  
5 five pounds being the sum required to defray the expenses of the  
various Departments and Services of the Colony from the first to the  
thirtieth June one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six And  
whereas we desire to make good out of the Consolidated Revenue  
Fund of New South Wales the sum so granted to Her Majesty Be it  
10 therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with  
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative  
Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the  
authority of the same as follows :—

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales £186,865 may be

The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

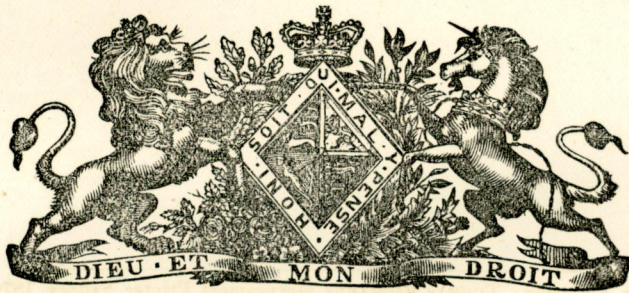

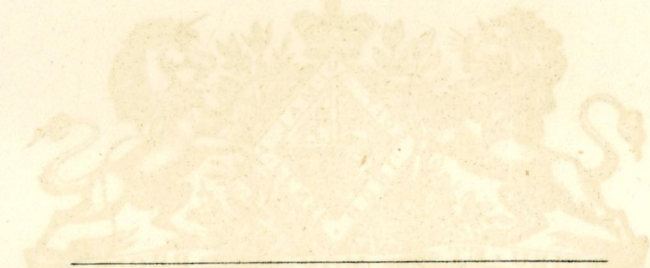
