VV the City Funds of the Municipal Council of Sydney was payable to the said Council in the year One thousand eight hundred and seventy-six And whereas the said sum was not so paid during the 5 said year and has not since been paid by reason of its having been transferred on thirtieth December One thousand eight hundred and seventy-six to the credit of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales And whereas it is expedient that the said grant of Ten thousand pounds should be made good out of the said Consolidated 10 Revenue Fund Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent
