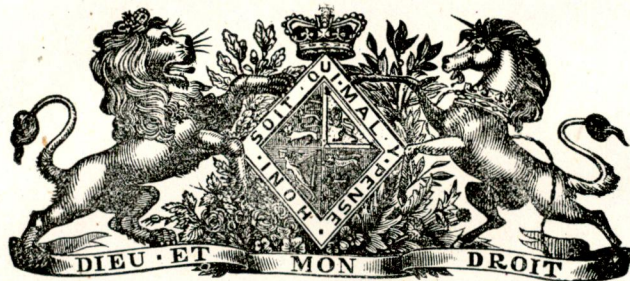

An Act for the abolition of the Duty on Gold.

WHEREAS it is expedient to abolish the duty on Gold Be it Preamble.
therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by

hereby abolished and the said Acts are hereby repealed.
