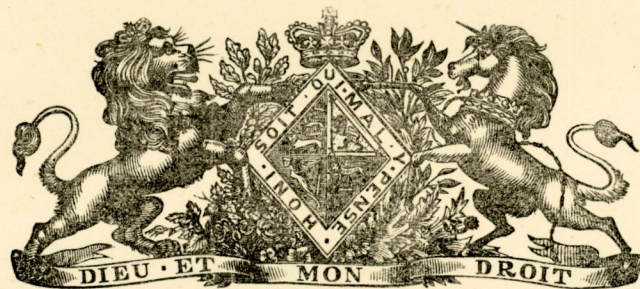

An Act for the abolition of the Duty on Gold.

WHEREAS it is expedient to abolish the duty on Gold Be it Preamble.
therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by
and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legis-
lative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by
5 the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The duty on Gold payable by virtue of the Acts twenty Duty on Gold
Victoriæ number seventeen and twenty-six Victoriæ number five abolished and Act
hereby abolished and the said Acts are hereby repealed. is 20 Vic. No. 17 and
26 Vict. No. 5
2. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of repealed.
