WHEREAS it is expedient to authorize the Government to borrow Preamble. certain sums of money amounting in the whole to Two hundred and thirty-five thousand six hundred and ninety pounds for the several purposes hereinafter specified Be it therefore enacted by 5 the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :---1. It shall be lawful for the Governor with the advice of the Loan of £235,690.

10 Executive Council to raise by the sale of Debentures secured upon the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony and bearing interest at a rate not exceeding four per centum per annum such several sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Two hundred and 438— thirtythirty-five thousand six hundred and ninety pounds as may be required for the following several purposes not exceeding for the same respectively the several sums respectively set against such purposes :-


