## MEDICAL BILL.

# (New Clause to be proposed in Committee of the Whole by MR. DOCKER to follow clause 7 of the Bill as printed.)

Every person who has been entered upon the register of any British Colony as a duly qualified medical or surgical practitioner or has been habitually engaged in the practice of medicine or surgery during a period of not less than ten years in the United Kingdom or British Colonies five years of which have been passed as a resident and practitioner in this Colony and if such person has received from any University or Medical College a diploma entitling him to practise medicine or surgery in the country to which such University or College belongs shall on application to the Medical Council and on proof of his qualification or title be entitled to be so registered on payment of the fee or fees due in that behalf.

### MEDICAL BILL.

# (New Clauses to be proposed in Committee of the Whole by SIR ALFRED STEPHEN.)

All diplomas and certificates of medical qualification recognized by the Council of Medical Education of the United Kingdom shall be equally recognized by the Council appointed under this Act.

#### (New clause between 32 and 33.)

32a. No meeting of its members shall be deemed a meeting of Quorum of Council. the Council unless duly convened nor unless *five* members at the least (including the President or member chosen as aforesaid) are present nor in proceedings under the fourteenth section unless *nine* members at the least are present.

#### (New section to follow section 10.)

10*a*. The Council shall also in the months of April July and Quarterly publication October cause to be published in the *Gazette* the names addresses and <sup>of names.</sup> qualifications of all practitioners registered during the preceding quarter and a copy of any such publication signed by the President shall be evidence for all purposes that the persons therein described were so registered.
