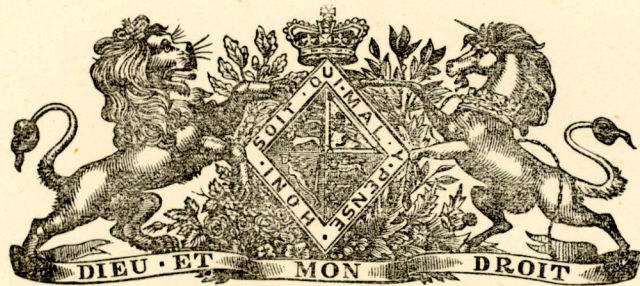

An Act to amend the Law respecting Verdicts of *Felo-de-se*.
[Assented to, 23rd February, 1876.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Law respecting the Preamble.
verdicts of Coroners' Juries in the case of death by Suicide
Be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the
advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly
of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority
of the same as follows :—

1. From and after the passing of this Act the verdict of *Felo-de-se* Verdicts of Felo-de-se
shall be and the same is hereby abolished abolished. Provided that nothing in
this Act contained shall affect the law with respect to attempts to
commit suicide.
