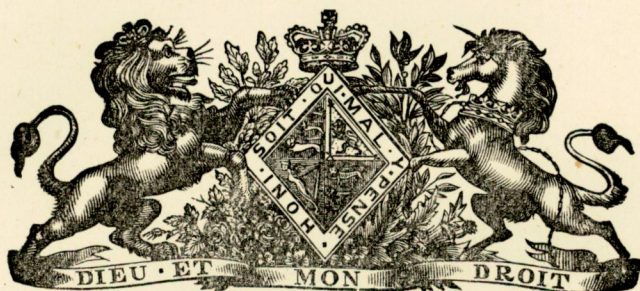

An Act for the abolition of the Duty on Gold. [Assented to,
15th July, 1879.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to abolish the duty on Gold Be it Preamble.
therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by
and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legis-
lative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by
the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The duty on Gold payable by virtue of the Acts twenty Duty on Gold abolished
and Acts 20 Vic. No. 17
and 26 Vic. No. 5
repealed.
Victoriæ number seventeen and twenty-six Victoriæ number five is
hereby abolished and the said Acts are hereby repealed.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of When to take effect.
October one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine.
