METROPOLITAN POLICE ACT EXTENSION ACT.

(Schedule of Amendments to be proposed in Committee of the Whole
by MR. MARKS.)

Section 1. *Omit* the words "and be in operation in" in the 9th line.

Section 2. *Insert* the words "or of the Act nineteenth Victoria
number twenty-four" after the word "aforesaid" in the 11th line.

Section 2. *Omit* all the words following the word "all" in the 12th
line to the end of the section and *insert* the words "police officers
and (except in the City or Port of Sydney or the hamlets or
suburbs thereof) all constables."

Section 3. *Insert* the word "first" before the words "aforesaid shall"
in the 19th line and the word "be" after those words.

Section 3. *Omit* the words "the respective" in the 20th line and
insert the words "of any" and in same line *omit* the words
"Districts of the Colony" and *insert* the word "District."

Section 3. *Insert* the words "shall be read" at the end of the 21st
line.

Section 3. *Omit* the words "the Police Offices of the Police Districts"
in the 22nd line and *insert* the words "Police Office"

Section 3. *Insert* the words at the end "And this Act shall be read
and construed as if its provisions were included in those Acts
respectively."

Add the following new section to stand as Section 4:—

4. Any person who shall cast any filth or rubbish into any
watercourse channel open sewer or canal or shall obstruct or divert
from its channel any public sewer or watercourse within any city town
or township shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding *five* pounds
and shall pay the cost of removing such filth rubbish or obstruction or
of restoring such watercourse or canal to its former condition. Or the
Justices before whom he shall be convicted may in their discretion
commit the person so offending to gaol or a house of correction for
any period not exceeding *one week* instead of inflicting any such
penalty or costs.

Section 1. *Omit* the words in the 7th and 8th lines between "one"
and "shall" and *omit* the words "and be in operation in"

Sections 2 and 3. *Omit* the whole and *substitute* the following
section:—

2. The word "City" wherever used in the said Act shall be held to apply to every other part of the Colony—the words "police office" shall mean and include "the nearest police office of a district"—
And every "constable" when in charge of a police district may within such district exercise the authority of an "Inspector" in the execution of the said Act or of the Act nineteenth Victoria number twenty-four and this Act shall be read and construed as if its provisions were included in those Acts respectively.

Police authority
