

3. ## No. XII.

An Act to extend the Act Seventeenth Victoria number thirty-one to all parts of the Colony. [Assented to, 28th March, 1878.]

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to extend the provisions of the Act Preamble. seventeenth Victoria number thirty-one to all places in the Colony of New South Wales Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. The Act seventeenth Victoria number thirty-one which is 17th Victoria No. 31 now in force within the City port hamlets and suburbs of Sydney extended to the whole Colony. shall extend and apply to all parts of the Colony.

2. The words "Superintendent" "Inspector" "Sergeant" and Interpretation. "Constable" whensoever used in the Act aforesaid shall be held to mean and include respectively any superintendent inspector sub-inspector sergeant or constable of the Police Force of the Colony in their respective Police districts or stations as the case may require and any Police officer or constable in charge of any Police district or **station**

3.
