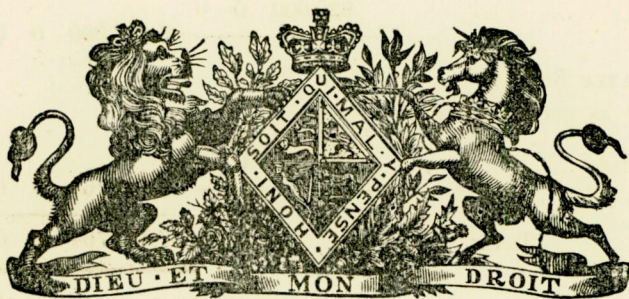

An Act to enable the Government to raise a Loan for certain
Public Works.

WHEREAS it is expedient to authorize the Government to borrow Preamble.
certain sums of money amounting in the whole to Seven
millions three hundred and fifty-two thousand seven hundred and
sixty-eight pounds for the several purposes hereinafter specified Be it
5 therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative
Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the
authority of the same as follows :—

1. It shall be lawful for the Governor with the advice of the Loan of £7,352,768.
10 Executive Council to raise by the sale of Debentures secured upon
the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony and bearing interest
at a rate not exceeding four per centum per annum such several sums
of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Seven millions three
hundred and fifty-two thousand seven hundred and sixty-eight pounds

2. All sums borrowed or authorized to be applied under this Act shall be paid to the Colonial Treasurer and shall be by him placed to the credit of the "General Loan Account."
3. The said Treasurer shall issue and pay the said several sums for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor by any warrant or order in writing under his hand and directed to the said Treasurer shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the General Loan Account aforesaid.
4. The said Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for every sum of money paid by him in pursuance of such warrant or order in writing as aforesaid. And the receipt of each and every person to whom the same shall be so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for each sum therein mentioned and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
5. This Act may be cited as the "Public Works Loan Act of 1879."

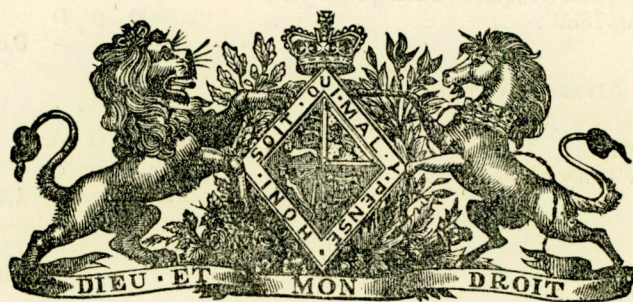
