
STANDARD WEIGHT FOR AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE BILL.

SCHEDULE of the Amendments referred to in Message of 21st January, 1880.

An Act to declare the Standard Weight of a Bushel of Maize Wheat Barley Oats Rye Peas and Beans.

WHEREAS it is expedient to declare the standard weight of a Preamble. bushel of maize wheat barley oats rye peas and beans respectively Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative 5 Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the

authority of the same as follows :-

1. All maize wheat barley oats rye peas and beans of every Maize wheat barley description shall be sold by weight and not by measure and every beans to be sold by person who shall sell any maize wheat barley oats rye peas or beans weight and 10 of any description by measure and not by weight shall on summary conviction before two Justices of the Peace be liable to a penalty not

exceeding five pounds for every such sale.

2. 1. Every contract bargain sale or dealing for any quantity of Contracts to be made maize wheat barley oats rye peas or beans sold delivered or agreed by bushel consisting 15 for if sold at per bushel shall be construed to be a contract for the number of pounds standard weight avoirdupois for each bushel as

annexed to the names of the several articles respectively in the Schedule to this Act annexed marked A. 3-150 -

Note.-The words to be omitted are ruled through; those to be inserted are printed in black letter.

Standard Weight for Agricultural Produce.

3. 2. Nothing herein contained shall be held to apply to any Act not to apply to contract bargain sale or dealing for any such agricultural produce contracts already made. as aforesaid made and entered into before the coming into operation of this Act or to any contract bargain sale or dealing for maize in the cob 5 or peas or beans in the pod.

4. Every plenalty for any offence against this Act may be Recovery of enforced and recovered upon summary conviction of such offence penalities. before any two Justices of the Peace and in case of non-payment thereof it shall be levied by distress and sale of the offender's goods

10 and chattels and on failure of distress shall be enforced in manner provided by the Alct eleventh and twelfth Victoria chapter forty-three as adopted by the fourteenth Victoria number forty-three and by any Acts-amending the same.

5. 3. So much of the sixteenth Victoria number thirty-four as is Repeal of so much of the 16 Vic. No. 34 as 15 inconsistent with this Act is hereby repealed.

An Act to declare the Standard Weight of a Bushel of Maize Wheat Barley Oats Rye Peas and Beans. [Assented to, 10th February, 1880.7

WHEREAS it is expedient to declare the standard weight of a Preamble. VV bushel of maize wheat barley oats rye peas and beans respectively Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the

authority of the same as follows:— 1. Every contract bargain sale or dealing for any quantity of Contracts to be made maize wheat barley oats rye peas or beans sold delivered or agreed by bushel consisting for if sold at per bushel shall be construed to be a contract for the number of pounds standard weight avoirdupois for each bushel as annexed to the names of the several articles respectively in the Schedule to this Act annexed marked A.

2. Nothing herein contained shall be held to apply to any Act not to apply to contract bargain sale or dealing for any such agricultural produce contracts already made.
