This Public Bill originated in the Legislative Assembly, and, having this day passed, is now ready for presentation to the Legislative Council for its concurrence.

## No.

An Act to enable the Municipal Council of the City of Sydney to purchase or otherwise become possessed of lands and other premises situate beyond the boundaries of the City which could be appropriated for the purpose of Public Baths or other public uses.

WHEREAS it is expedient to empower the Municipal Council of Preamble. the City of Sydney to acquire sites beyond the boundaries of the City for the establishment of Public Baths or for other public purposes and to make further provision in respect thereof Be it therefore 5 enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Municipal Baths Site Acqui-short title and 10 sition Act" "Land" means real estate held for any estate or interest interpretation. whatsoever and includes any buildings or erections thereon "Lease" includes an agreement for a lease "Council" means the Council of the Municipality of the City of Sydney.

2. On and after the passing of this Act it shall be lawful for Purchase or lease of 15 the Council to purchase or lease any land within ten miles of any of land for erection of the boundaries of the City of Sydney for the purpose of acquiring a site or sites and thereupon to erect and establish Public Baths or for other public use.
