THEREAS the "Married Women's Property Act" being the Act Preamble. woman married after the passing of the said Act becomes entitled under the "Real Estate of Intestates Distribution Act of 1862" or 5 any Act amending the same to an estate of freehold or to any interest in the proceeds of any sale thereof the interest in such proceeds or the rents and profits of such property shall belong to such woman for her separate use and her receipts alone shall be a good discharge for the same And whereas no provision is contained in the said Act for the 10 case of a married woman becoming entitled under any deed or will to real estate or any interest therein And whereas it is expedient to amend the said Act so as to remedy such defect Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly 15 of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of

the same as follows: 1. The provisions contained in section eight of the "Married Realty &c. coming to Women's Property Act" shall apply to the case of a woman married to belong to her. after the passing of such Act becoming entitled under any deed or
