Services the sum of One million five hundred and thirty-three thousand three hundred and sixty-seven pounds of which the sum of Five hundred and sixty-seven thousand pounds is to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five inclusive of the annual increases on salaries for that year provided for by the "Civil Service Act of 1884" subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six and Nine hundred and sixty-six thousand three hundred and sixty-seven pounds for the 10 Services specified in the Schedule hereto annexed.

2. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sum for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand and directed to the said Treasurer shall from time to time order and direct 15 And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony.

3. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders And the receipts of the respective persons to 20 whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
