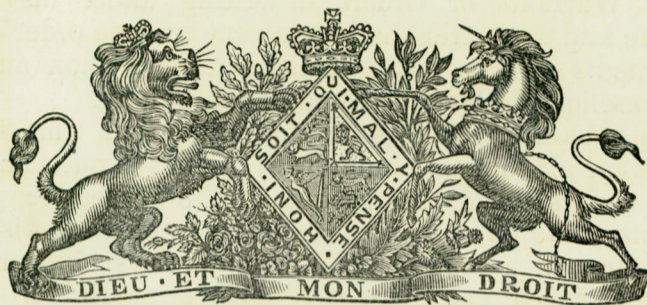

the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Six hundred and sixty thousand pounds that is to say—

The sum of Five hundred and ten thousand pounds being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the Colony for the month of June or following month of the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six And

The sum of One hundred and fifty thousand pounds for the Services set forth in the Schedule hereto annexed

And whereas we desire to make good out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales the sum so granted to Her Majesty Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—
