4. At any such polling place so to be appointed as aforesaid the execute at such polling place the returning officer shall exercise and execute the several powers several powers of the authorities and duties provided by the Principal Act for carrying into effect contested elections of aldermen or auditors.

5. At every contested election of aldermen or auditors after the passing of this Act the voting shall commence at eight o'clock in the forenoon and shall finally close at five o'clock in the afternoon.
