BILL CONCERNING THE BANKING BUSINESS

(Submitted to be passed in Committee of the Whole)

Section 10. That any person who shall be guilty of any offence under this Act shall be liable to the payment of a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars or to imprisonment for one year or to both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.
