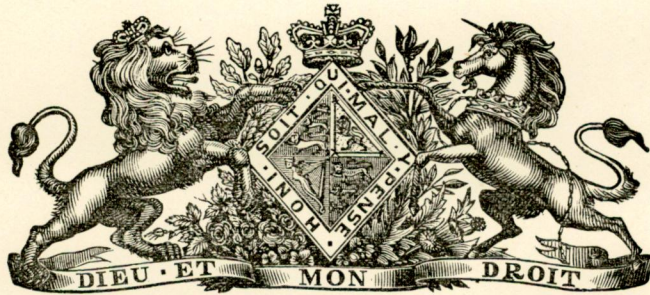

An Act to alter the name of the Borough of Redfern to the City of Redfern.

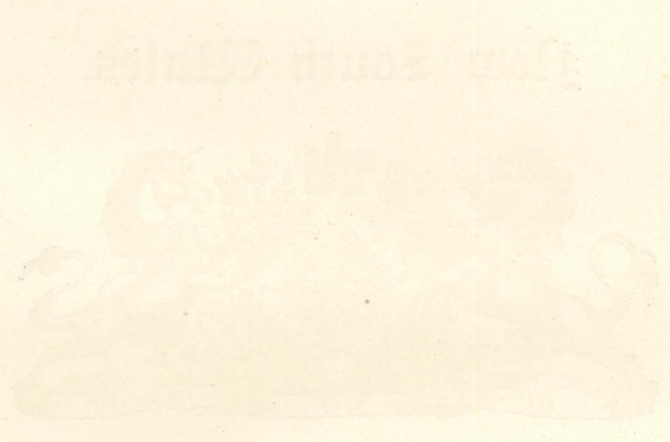
WHEREAS it is expedient to alter the name of the Borough of Redfern. Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 5 1. From and after the passing of this Act the name of the Borough of Redfern shall be and the same hereby is altered to the name of the City of Redfern. Alteration of name Borough of Redfern to City of Redfern.
- 10 2. The said City of Redfern shall be a body corporate, and shall by such name have perpetual succession and a common seal, and be capable in law of suing and being sued, and of purchasing, holding, and alienating land, and of exercising all such corporate functions and doing and suffering all such acts and things as by law and in conformity with the "Municipalities Act of 1867" and all amending Acts relating City of Redfern a body corporate, &c.
- 15 3. This Act may be cited and styled as the "City of Redfern Naming Act of 1889." Short title.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE INCOME TAX ACT, 1918, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE COLLECTION OF THE SAME.

ENACTED BY THE KING'S MOST EXCELLENT Majesty, by His Majesty's Command, in this behalf present, the following Provisions, that—

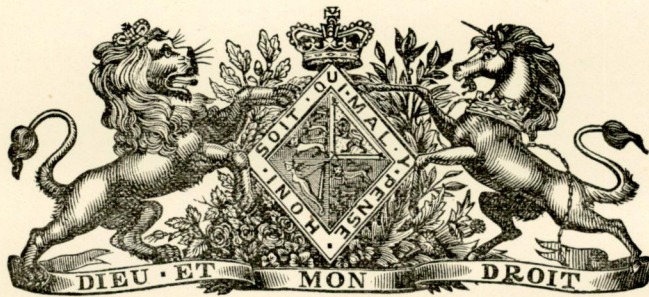

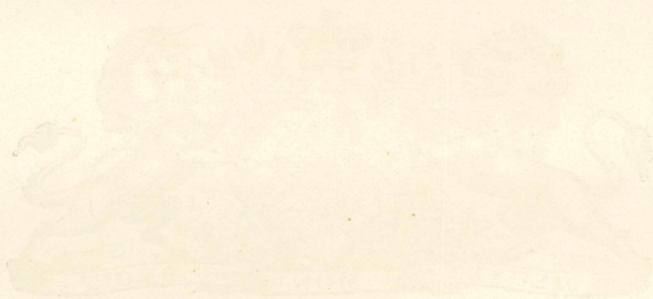
