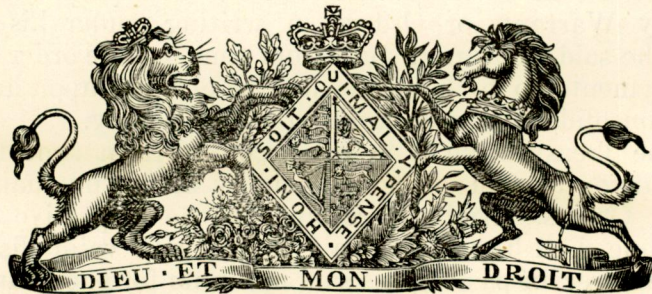

**W**HEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects Preamble. the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Five hundred and ninety-three thousand one hundred and seventy pounds, that is to say—

The sum of Four hundred and ninety thousand six hundred and seventy pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the Colony for the month of August, or following month of the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine. And

The sum of One hundred and two thousand five hundred pounds for the Services set forth in the Schedule hereto annexed.

And whereas we desire to make good out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales the sum so granted to Her Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with

Treasurer to pay under Governor's Warrant or Order.

And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony.
