

2. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sum for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable 20 out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Colony.

3. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. And the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges 25 to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

An Act to apply certain Sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales, towards the Services of the Year 1889.

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects Preamble. the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of One million two hundred and twenty thousand two hundred 5 and thirty-seven pounds, that is to say—

The sum of Four hundred and ninety thousand six hundred and seventy pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the Colony for the month of April, or following month of the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine. And

The sum of Seven hundred and twenty-nine thousand five hundred and sixty-seven pounds for the Services set forth in the Schedule hereto annexed :
