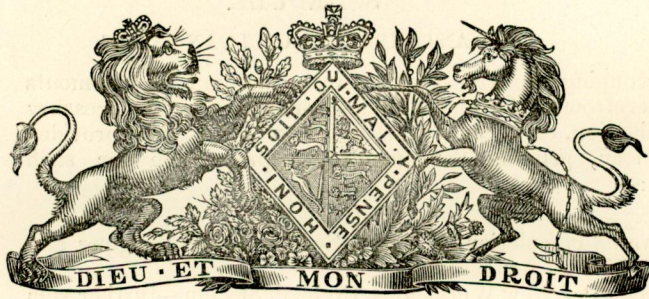

An Act to apply certain Sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales, for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan. [Assented to, 7th October, 1890.]

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Three hundred and twenty thousand two hundred and sixty-one pounds, for the Services set forth in the Schedule hereto annexed. And whereas we desire to make good out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales the sum so granted to Her Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty the sum of Three hundred and twenty thousand two hundred and sixty-one pounds, for the Services specified in the Schedule hereto annexed.
