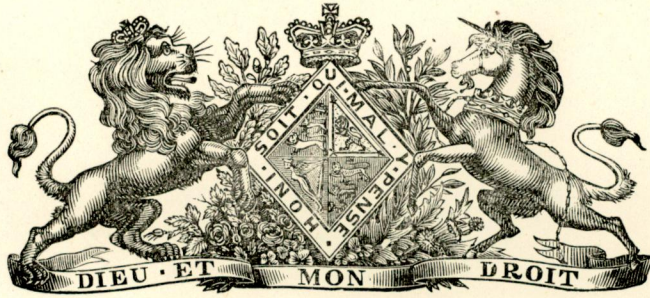

An Act to facilitate the granting of Probate of Wills and Letters of Administration.

**W**HEREAS the practice of moving in Court for probate of wills Preamble. and letters of administration is productive of much delay and expense in obtaining such probate and letters of administration. Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. All applications for probate of wills or letters of administration shall be made by petition to the Judges of the Supreme Court Applications for probates and administrations to be made by petition. of the Colony of New South Wales.
2. This Act may be cited for all purposes as the "Granting of Short title. Probate of Wills and Letters of Administration Facilitation Act of 1890."

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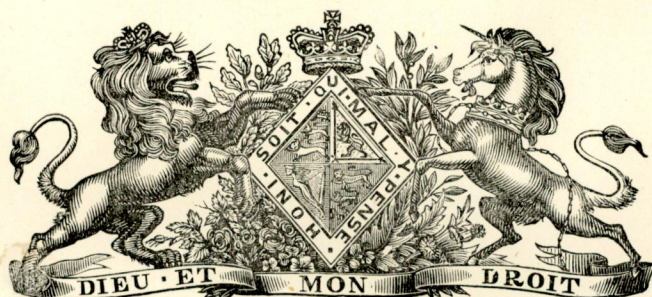
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2. This Act may be cited for all purposes as the "Granting of Probate of Wills and Letters of Administration Facilitation Act of 1890." Short title.

# NEW SOUTH WALES

AND OUTLAWING ACTS

## VICTORIAN BILL

No.

Act to facilitate the granting of Proofs of Wills and Letters of Administration.

WHEREAS the practice of applying to the Court for probate of wills, and for letters of administration, is a source of much delay and expense in obtaining such probate and letters of administration; and it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Privy Council and Legislature, that the Act in that behalf made in Parliament assembled, and by the Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

1. All applications for probate of wills or letters of administration shall be made by petition to the Judge of the Supreme Court of the Colony of New South Wales.  
2. This Act may be cited for all purposes as the "Facilitating of Proofs of Wills and Letters of Administration Act of 1880."
