

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :— 1. The presence of twenty Members of the Legislative Council, Quorum in exclusive of the President, shall at every sitting of the House, and the fixed.

5 1. The presence of twenty Members of the Legislative Council, Que exclusive of the President, shall at every sitting of the House, and the fix presence of sixteen Members, exclusive of the Chairman shall, at every sitting in Committee of the Whole, be sufficient to constitute a Quorum for the despatch of business—anything in the eighth section of the 10 "Constitution Act" notwithstanding.
