**W**HEREAS it is expedient to enable persons charged with any offence, and the husband or wife of any person so charged, to give evidence on the hearing of any such charge. Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. From and after the passing of this Act, on the trial of a person charged with any offence whatsoever, the person so charged, and the husband or wife of such person, shall be competent but not compellable to be a witness and give evidence, and, as such witness, shall be subject to cross-examination.

2. This Act may be cited as the "Evidence for Defendants Extension Act."
